

## 'Suspended Manuu drivers knew of termination order'

**Hyderabad:** In response to allegations made by four former employees of Manuu about the termination of their services without any prior notice or reason, the varsity's registrar Dr MA Sikandar said that all the four knew that the termination orders were passed after the UGC had declared the posts unapproved and illegal.

According to varsity officials, the four driver posts were filled up in February 2014 without waiting for UGC approval.

However, Manuu pursued the matter with UGC later and the proposal was rejected. As a result, the posts were termed unapproved. "An unanimous decision was taken in a meeting called by the VC after UGC rejected the proposal" he said.
