The short course in Hyderabad is under the banner of FTII's nationwide outreach initiative titled 'Skilling India in Film and Television' (SKIFT) under which courses are held across the country and round the year.

Film appreciation will strive to introduce film lovers to cinema as an academic discipline and will broadly cover four streams including history, film analysis and documentary films and film making.

Course Director, Pankaj Saxena is a film maker, television programmer and film academician based in New Delhi while Munish Bhardwaj has written for television series Bhanwar, Rajdhani and Hadsa.

"Film making will take participants through the little known process of film making and provides a good idea to the student about how films are made - conceptually, technically and aesthetically," said Pankaj Saxena.

In film history, participants will be briefed on the scientific inventions that led to the advent of cinema and take them through the work of pioneers, who laid down the grammatical precepts of this medium. Film Analysis will deal with three basic elements of cinematic art i.e. picture, sound and sequencing. TT

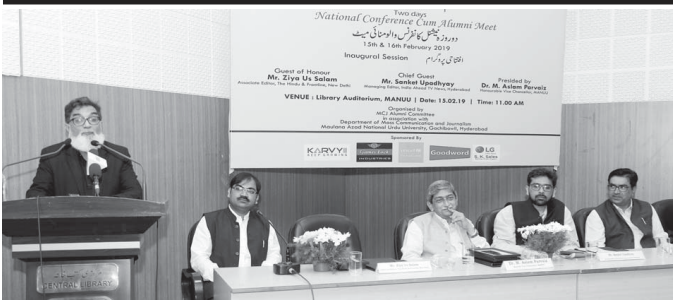

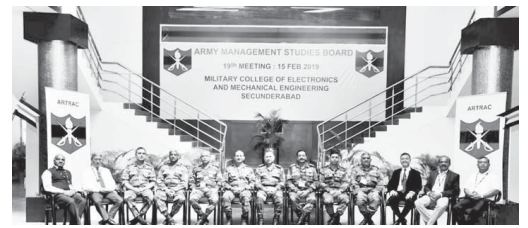
