

Minutes of the Meeting

The following are the Resolutions of the School Board meeting held on 5th July, 2012.

1. As per the agenda, the Chairman apprised the members about the progress made to date to the satisfaction of the members of the School board.
2. The School board members comprehensively examined various papers being offered at MA MCJ course, PG Diploma Graphic & Animation, M.Phil, PhD programmes of the MCJ Department, alongwith new papers included in the MA MCJ course as approved by the BOS members. The School board members approved the revised syllabus of M.A.MCJ and recommended to implement with effect from the current academic year 2012-13.
3. The school board members approved the launch of PG Diploma in Graphics and Animations from the current Academic year 2012-2013. They also approved the syllabus alongwith title of the papers, eligibility, course duration, selection process, intake, title of the course, as approved by the BOS members. Moreover the School Board has recommended the fees to be reduced from Rs 15,000/- to Rs 10,000/-. The school board members approved the pattern of Entrance test for PG Diploma course as approved by the BOS members, and to run this course as fulltime course. Keeping in view the introductory course, the School board members advised that the MCJ Department may launch this course from this academic year (2012-13) with a minimum intake of 5 (five) students out of its total strength of 15 seats.
4. The School board members approved the proposal to introduce M.Phil and PhD progammes from the current academic year 2012-13, by the MCJ Department. The School board members also approved the syllabus and guidelines for the M.Phil and PhD course of the MCJ Department.
5. The School board members approved the local field visits for the students of MA MCJ course of all semesters. Further the School board members recommended that a vehicle may be hired for the same for the above said purpose till permanent arrangement is made in future.
6. The School board members approved the list of paper setters and evaluators presented for MA MCJ course and PG Diploma in Graphics and Animation.

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
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
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
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7. The School board members approved the educational tour for MA MCJ students to Delhi or Mumbai for a duration of 10 days as approved by the BOS members.






