I worked as editor for BATHA Urdu Monthly Hyderabad. Besides, I worked in a reputed multinational corporation (MNC) as senior Arabic-English translator and interpreter.

I specialize in Indo-Arab Comparative Studies. The aim of my PhD project is to carry out a descriptive and comparative study of the famous Arabic novel *Salwa Fi Mahabbel Rih*, written by Mahmood Taimur (1894 –1973) and classical Urdu novel *Umrao Jan Ada*, written by Mirza Muhammad Hadi Ruswa (1857 –1931). In this dissertation, efforts have been made to compare the two novels, apparently different from each other in respect of time, space and language — by throwing light on aspects and features prevailing in both novels. The novels are similar in the portrayal of their issues and characters. The dissertation shows that both novels have drawn sustenance from the social issues of the period of their writing. The perspectives of the two authors on the social issues are discussed.

The areas of my general interest are: Modern Arabic Literature, novel, history of Islam, Arab world, and integration of students from Madrasa background into contemporary education system.
