- 9.6 To seek ratification of the decision taken by the Departmental Research Committee (DRC).

#### The resolution of the 9th BoS is as follows:

- 9.1.1 The Chairman of BoS apprises about action taken regarding previous BoS & School Board.
- 9.2.1 The Chairman of BoS apprises about of progress made by the Department of Mass Communication and Journalism till date and elaborated and presented the draft MOU about establishing 'Prof. Manzurul Amin and Rafia Memorial Scholarship' annually for two (02) students of M.A.(JMC) against the deposited amount of Rs. 1,00,000/- by the sponsors, Dr. Zeeshan Samiuddin MD & Ms. Farozan Warsi (Daughters of Late Professor Manzurul Amin Sb) presently based at USA and Canada/Saudi Arabia. Moreover, he informed that the daughters of Professor Manzurul Amin donated many books/writings/audio-video tapes of archival values to the Departmental Library of MCJ.

Further, he presented and explained about the draft MOU with UNICEF, which is in final stage and have many benefits to MCJ students as given below:

a. UNICEF will provide the CAS syllabus in Urdu and organize two full day orientation workshops for the faculty members who will be divided into two batches. The workshops will be attended by 6 faculty members of MANUU and 15 working journalists of the Urdu media from Hyderabad. The Department will include Health Journalism as one of the elective papers of M.A. (JMC) as well as one of the elective papers of the UG course i.e. B. A. (JMC) from the next academic year 2018-19.

b. UNICEF will provide technical materials such as reports, key messages, and training material, leveraging its knowledge base.

c. UNICEF will also organize and fund a national level Seminar/Conference in Hyderabad which will be attended by senior members from the media fraternity and academia. This Seminar/Conference will be organized after completion of one year after the agreement came into effect.

d. UNICEF will support the translation of existing material and collaterals to facilitate the integration of the CAS course at MANUU.

- e. UNICEF will support at least of Five (05) students for field visit by PG students/PHD scholars for research every year.
- b. The Chairman of BoS also informed about the progress of MOU with FTII, Pune for short term course and MOU with IIMC, New Delhi.
- 9.3.1 The members of BoS approved the revised and restructured syllabus of M.A. (JMC) course with following modifications:
  - i. The title of the subject "Media Law and Society", which is offered in second semester as core will be changed to "Media Law and Ethics".
  - ii. The title of the subject "Web and Convergent Journalism" which is offered in third semester as core will be changed to "Online Journalism".

iii. The topic of 'Sports Journalism' should be added in paper of Print Journalism.

- iv. Further, the members of BoS suggested that instead of one month internship, the modalities may be worked out by the concerned faculty of respective subject to send the students in different media organisations/institutions across all the semesters. To have a better understanding of academic and industry interface, the letters to editors may be send in advance through HOD by respective faculty of concerned subjects/speciation. It was suggested that students may be encouraged to undertake assignments related to 'Education Supplement' of different newspapers. It was also suggested that if possible the course/practical's/assignments of each semester may be completed before 15 days of the scheduled exam of University by the concerned faculties and students may be sent to different media organisations to undertake 15 days internship in each semester.
- V. The revised and restructured syllabus of M.A. (JMC) course will be effective from the next academic year, 2018-19.
- 9.4.1 The members of BoS approved the revised/restructured syllabus of B.A. (JMC) course as per CBCS pattern of the University which will be introduced from the next academic year (2018-19).
- 9.5.1 The Board of Studies approved the list of paper setters and evaluators of B.A. (JMC), M.A. (JMC) and Ph.D. (JMC) Courses and authorize Chairman, BoS/HOD to include some more names in the list of Paper Setters and Evaluators of B.A. (JMC), M.A. (JMC) course and authorize Chairman, DRC to include some more names in the list of Paper Setters and Evaluators Ph.D. (JMC) Course.
- 9.6.1 The Board of Studies approved the decision taken by the Departmental Research Committee (DRS) held on 11<sup>th</sup> October 2017 and 20<sup>th</sup> December 2017.
- 9.7.1 The Board of Studies approved the syllabus of Diploma in Journalism and Mass Communication (DJMC) course of the DDE. But the members of BoS have recommended reviewing the content of the existing SLM urgently and the content may be prepared for SLM which should have updated content relevant to the industry needs.
- 9.8.1 Prof. Prof. K. R. Iqbal Ahmed, Director, DDE, MANUU has suggested to start a master programme of M.A. (JMC) through distance mode, but the matter has been differed as members have reminded that it is not possible the course without practical facility which is essentially required for professional course. Further, the Chairman, BoS has suggested to offer one year PG Diploma in Journalism and Mass Communication (DJMC) for graduate students through distance mode. The Department of MCJ may offer and design a lateral entry course of one year through regular mode for said students and they may be accorded a Masters Degree, accordingly.

The Chairman, BOS extended his sincere thanks to all the members for their valuable contribution and meeting concluded with Vote of Thanks to the Chairman.
