Shredding Machines at Rail Stations for greener environment

SCR installs Bottle

Hyderabad, May 6: Usage of packaged drink-ing water during travel in trains has enormously increased, especially in summer season, Railway stations are the places which witness mass accu-mulation of used water bottles and maintenance of cleanliness has become a Herculean task. Disposal of the empty water bottles has become a major hurdle in the implementation of environmen-

tal friendly waste disposal system. Secunderabad, Hyderabad, Kacheguda, Lingampalli and other major suburban stations located in heart of the twin cities witness huge footfall of passengers and usage of water bottles is also very high. Carrying plastic wastage to dump yards and proper disposal was a challenging task for environmental friendly system. To mitigate the problem of accumulated plastic material and helping greener environment, Secunderabad Division of South Central Railway has installed 22 bottle shredding machines at different railway stations in the twin cities of Hyderabad and Secunderabad. The bottle shredders are installed through funds provided under Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR). The list of stations with number of bottle shredder machines installed is – Secunderabad 12; Hvderabad 5; Necklace Road 1; Begumpet 1; Hafizpet 1; Hi Tech City 1 and Lingampalli 1.
South Central Railway was creating awareness

amongst passengers for utilizing the Bottle Shred-ders Machines to dispose the used water bottles. At present, some 600 bottles are being shredded by the passengers themselves at Secunderabad Station and some 300 bottles at Hyderabad station per day. The shredded pieces thus collected in the bottom trav of the machines and the same material can be used to recycle in an environmental friendly manner. These Bottle crushing machines are user friendly and each bottle is shredded into pieces in 3 to 5 seconds. In addition to station premises, these bottle shredders are also installed in the Coach Maintenance Yard and Central Waste Collection Bin at Secunderabad station to enable the cleaning staff to easily dispose collected pet bottles while cleaning the coach.

Cong asks IT Dept to probe into assets of TRS MLAs

Hyderabad, May 6 : Welcoming the notices sent by the Income Tax Department to over 40 TRS MLAs, including Chief Minister

Chandrashekhar Rao, seeking explanation into huge rise in their assets in the last 4-5 years, the Congress party de-manded that the IT De-partment conduct a detailed probe into the issue.

"There is no doubt that many ruling TRS MLAs have accumulated huge wealth through illegal means and their assets were disproportionate to their know sources of in-come. The IT Department should either conduct a high-level probe or rec-ommend CBI or judicial enquiry into the swindling of public money by the ruling party legislators, Telangana Pradesh Con-gress Committee (TPCC) Treasurer Gudur Naravana

Reddy said in a media state ment on Monday. Narayana Reddy pointed out that KCR fam-

ily and other TRS MLAS have earned huge wealth in very a short time. "KCR family has officially entered the Rs. 100 Crore Club. KCR's is apparently the only family to have earned assets of more than Rs. 100 Crore with-out actually doing any known business. Entire world knows that KCR and all his family members are full time politicians. But all five family mem bers who are in politics have earned hune assets

As per the latest affi-davits filed by KCR and his family before the Election Commission, they have declared assets of Rs. 111.54 Crore, They include Chandrashekhar Rao - Rs. 23.55 Cr; K. Taraka Rama Rao - Rs. 41.82 Cr; T. Harish Rao -Rs. 11.44 Cr; K. Kavitha -Rs. 17.93 Cr and J. Santosh Kumar - Rs.

16.80 Crore. While Telangana movement was at its

peak, KCR was increasing his assets. He's continued that earning spree even now. His assets increased from just Rs. 85.95 lakh in 2004 to Rs. 23.55 Cr by December 2018. Therefore, KCR's assets have increased by 2,638% since 2004. While three members of the family (KCR, KTR and Harish Rao) cumulatively increased assets of Rs. 18.81 Cr from 2009-2014, their fourth member (K Kavitha) joined them in 2014 and their cumulative assets increased by Rs. 62.46 Cr in the last 4-5 years. At this pace and also the addition of another member (Santosh Kumar), one can expect the KCR family to add another Rs. 100 Cr or more assets in the next five years, he said.

two more cases: Sources New Delhi, May 6: The Election Commission has en clean chit to Prime Minister Narendra Modi in two more cases, sources aware of the development said Monday.

The Congress had al-leged that he held a "roadshow" in Ahmedabad on April 23 and the sources said the commission has concluded that Modi did not violate the model code and the election law.

They said that the ommission has also cleared Modi for his April speech at Chitradurga in Karnataka where he had reportedly asked new voters to dedicate their vote for the heroes of the Balakot air strike. On the same day, he

had made a similar appeal in Ausa in Latur district of Maharashtra. The EC had given a clean chit to him in that case as well, but one of the election commissioners had given a dissenting view in the matter,Though the commission has so far not made the two decisions public, with these decisions, Modi has been given a clean chit in eight matters. The poll authorities in Gujarat are learnt to have maintained that prima facie no violation was found. The Congress had moved the EC alleg-
