Hyderabad, April 16: Chief Secretary SK Joshi today said a draft plan will be ready to accord permissions from several departments to hold festivals, exhibitions and meetings in the State.

The Chief Secretary held a high-level meeting at Secretariat today and asked the officials to prepare a perfect draft plan

to give permissions to several programs. He instructed the officials to coordinate and ensure speedy permissions to any sort of meetings, functions and exhibitions in the State. Managements or those involved in the programs should give self certification to obtain necessary permis-sions, he said The government will give instructions on holding similar events or programs at permanent buildings and temporary buildings. These programs will be categorized and sugges-tions will be given on operation protocol and norms to be followed for the same. He also said the police officials will hold field level checkups

for smooth and peaceful conduct of the events. For programs like fish adam and Numavish or industrial exhibition in Nampally, the depart-ments will coordinate and give guidelines for smooth conduct of such events. Proforma of permissions will be easy and hasslefree with a focus on secu-

Goa BJP govt's performance below average: ADR

New Delhi, April 16 (GNS): The BJP government in Goa performed "poorly and underwhelmingly" on almost all governance parameters important for voters, including employment, sanitation, healthcare and food prices, according to a report by the Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR)

"The Goa Survey Report 2018 points to the fact that voters' priorities in Goa have been neglected by the government in power. This is quite clear from the fact that the government has performed poorly and underwhelmingly on a majority of top 10 governance issues as rated by the voters of Goa," the survey, conducted between October and December 2018 and released on Tuesday, said.

According to the report, employment, better gar-

bage clearance and lower food prices for consumers were top priorities for voters across the state who voted the government's performance as "below average" on all three. In rural areas, the concerns were employment opportunities, food prices and better healthcare, and the government performed below average on these as well, the report said It scored 2.66 on a scale of 5 on employment, 2.56 on food prices for consumers and 2.65 on availability of better hospitals and primary healthcare centres, it said."In addition, the government has performed poorly on better public transport (2.46) and better garbage dear-ance (2.5) in rural Goa." According to the survey, employment, traffic congestion and garbage clearance vere major concerns for urban voters

Hyderabad, April 16: The Congress party has alleged that the Lok Sabha elections, held in first and single phase in Telangana State on April 11, might have been officially rigged.

Addressing the media at Gandhi Bhavan on Tuesday, TPCC official spokesperson Syed Nizamuddiin has accused the EC of tampering with the polling figures to benefit the ruling TRS. "The difference between the polling percentage till 5 pm and Final Voter turn-out is huge, Election authorities might have adjusted the figures to suit the requirement of TRS, he alleged The Congress

different video clips pertaining to Telangana wherein some unidenti-fied people are seen taking away EVMs in an autorickshaw and a car. He said many such clips of private individuals possessing EVMs are in circulation in social media. While this clearly strengthens suspicion that EVMs have been manipulated, the silence and inaction of Election Commission on such complaints proves that the elections were officially rigged. "If Election Commission doesn't want to hold polling in a fair manner, then it should directly give winning certificate to the candidate of ruling party immediately after filing nomination. It need not enact the drama of holding polls by wasting hundreds of crores of public money and everyone's

time," he said. Nizamuddin manded that the Election Commission place boothwise and hour-wise figures of polling for all 17 constituencies in public domain. He said these figures should be cross-checked with the CCTV footage of polling stations and they must match with the votes to be counted in EVMs. In case of any mismatch, there should be re-polling in the entire constituency.

4 of 44 MPs in LS polls 2nd phase asked no question

New Delhi, April 16 (GNS): According to an official data, only four of the 44 sitting candidates conte the second phase of the Lok Sabha elections had asked zero questions in the Parliament, including Janata Dal (Secular)'s H.D. Devegowda.A total of 97 Lok Sabba constituencies across 12 states go to the second phase of the general elections on Thursday.

Apart from Devegowda, BJP's Yashwant Singh elected from Uttar Pradesh's Nagina; Congress' K.H. Muniyappa, elected from Karnataka's Kolar; and All India Trinamool Con-gress' Bijoy Chandra Barman, elected from West Bengal's Jalpaiguri, did not ask any questions in the House.

"The four did not move any Private Members' Bill," according to the data shared by PRS Legislative Research.

On the other hand, the highest number of questions among the 44 MPs were asked by Shiv Sena's Anandrao Adsul, Adsul asked 1,062

questions in the Lok Sabha between June 1, 2014 and February 13, 2019, it said With 906 questions, Congress MP Ashok Shankarrao Chavan, elected from Maharashtra's Nanded, came second in the list in terms of questions, All India Anna Dravida Munnetra Kazhagam's J. Jayavardhan, elected from Tamil Nadu's Chennai South, asked 816 questions in the House, according to the data. Congress' Biren Singh Engti, elected from Assam's Autonomous District, raised only one question in the House.

Among the 44 MPs, four were Min-

isters in the Cabinet, D.V. Sadananda Gowda, Jitendra Singh, Jual Oram and P Radhakrishnan were represent-Jitendra Singh, Jual Oram ing the government in the House The 97 constituencies across Assam, Bihar, Chhattisgarh, Karnataka, Jammu and Kashmir, Maharashtra Manipur, Odisha, Tamil Nadu, Tripura, Uttar Pradesh, and West Bengal go to polls in the second phase.
